Hopes for the Future

This is just a short note to help you while away the time during your treatment session and perhaps give you some food for thought.

If you are or have been a patient this year you are in a similar situation as thousands all over the world who also use hyperbaric oxygen as an important part of their medical management. During your one hour treatment , you will breath around 1200 litres of oxygen made for you on these premises, and your treatment will be one of over 15000 that we have carried out in the last twelve months.

The cost of providing this service is supported by the health service and by charitable donations. In the United States of America the patients are charged up to \$1000 per treatment session. In Europe 480 Euros and in Wirral just a few miles from us £350.

Our aim is to keep treatments free for patients and our ability to do this depends on the continuing generosity of those supplying funding and donations. It costs £1000 per week to run the facility. If you are in a position to fund raise or donate, your ongoing support will be greatly appreciated.

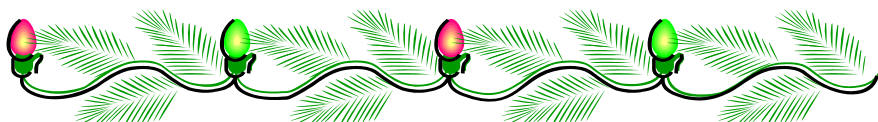
